**A.Lakshminarayanan** of Final Year ECE got State Level Best Student Award from IE(I) on 11.03.19.

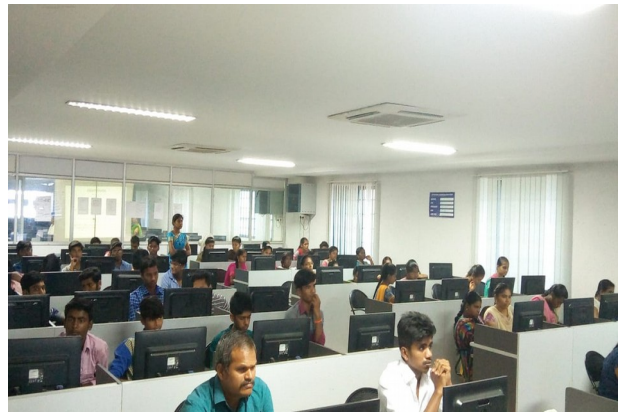
