



Annual Report 2021 - 2022

I am pleased to present the annual report for the academic year 2021–2022. Several initiatives to promote development have taken place at the college over the years.

- A total of 679 students were admitted out of 765 sanctioned intakes; around 88.76% were admitted in all programs.
- The International Conference on “Impact of Engineering, Science and Management on Digital Transformation (IESMDT-2021)” was organized on September 17, 2021.
- The academic year classes for Second, Third and Final were started on 18/8/21 and for First Year on 22/11/21.
- We are delighted to share that our college got the 48th rank in academic performance among 314 engineering colleges in the Anna University examination held in April and May 2022.
- We are glad to inform you that three of our UG students got **University Rank** in this academic year.
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- We have conducted 16 Value-added courses for the enhancement of the students’ knowledge and competencies.
- This academic year, the students received 1594 government scholarships and 450 non-government scholarships.
- In this academic year, a total 15 research papers were published in National and International journal by faculty members.
- There were total of 11 papers published in various National and International Conferences conducted by faculty members in this academic year.
- Totally, 89 faculty members have attended FDP programs, and totally, 28 non-teaching members have attended skill enhancement programs.

- Faculty members were encouraged to attend conference and workshops with financial support. This academic year, financial support was provided to 89 faculties to attend various academic programs.
- A total of 378 students have been placed in various companies with high packages during this academic year.
- An Alumni meet was conducted on January 26, 2022.
- Annual Day “CAPSTONE” was celebrated on 28th April 2022
- The NSS unit has conducted nine extension and outreach programs for the benefit of the society.
- Total grants of Rs. 5.64 lakhs were received for 14 research projects from both government and Non-government agencies.
