Annual Report 2022 - 2023

I am happy to present the annual report for the academic year 2022–2023. This year has been a progressive one with many developments.

- A total of 720 students were admitted out of 765 sanctioned intakes; around 94.12% were admitted in all programs.
- We are delighted to share that our college got the 48th rank in academic performance among 313 engineering colleges in the Anna University examination held in November and December 2022.
- The academic year classes for Second, Third and Final were started on 10/8/22 and for First Year on 28/11/22.
